

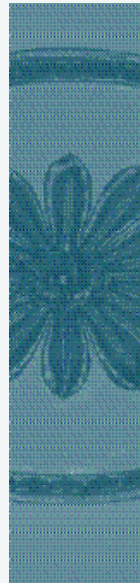
**15 Usher's Island**
